Re: June 2, 2003 Summons that you sent me.

Dear Ms. Steburg,

I am in receipt of a summons that you or two of your associates on May 19, 2003 hand delivered to my residence in Phelan California, about 80 miles away from your office, to appear in your office on June 2, 2003. I am willing to meet with you. That is not a problem. However, your actions leave me in much confusion as to what this is all about. If you clarify what is going on I will be better able to assist you in the matter at hand. I hope you will aid me in this process. **My questions to you are in bold letters.**

First on April 16, 2003 your Area Director sends me a hand signed (not computer generated) letter (hereafter, "THE IRS LETTER") in which it asks me to meet with you on May 15, 2003. In response, on April 30, 2003, I sent a Privacy Act/FOIA request to your Disclosure Office and your D.C. Disclosure Office to see what you are talking about in your letter. In addition, I sent a letter to you on May 14, 2003 (thereafter, "RESPONSE LETTER") asking you a few simple questions about the nature and purpose of your proposed May 15, 2003 meeting.

Your Disclosure Office, by relying on completely frivolous objection, refused to give me anything and your D.C. office did not even acknowledge the receipt of my letter. You did NOT answer ANY of my simple questions. Instead of giving me some simple clarifications, you and another associate of yours (or 2 other IRS agents) drove 80 miles from your office to hand deliver a Summons to me at my residence in Phelan.

Were you trying to get out of the cooped up cubicle of your Santa Ana office and get some fresh/smog free air or did you have a valid reason for not taking **a few minutes to type up a clarification letter**; instead of taking 3 hours to drive back and forth to my residence to hand deliver me a summons?

This Summons of yours confuses me even more about what is going on and what you are trying to accomplish with me. The IRS LETTER stated that the date of the May 15, 2003 meeting "will not be extended." In my RESPONSE LETTER I asked you if the May 15, 2003 meeting is

an audit, summons or some other kind of a meeting. You did NOT answer this **simple question** of mine.

Instead you issued a Summons dated May 15, 2003 to appear before you on June 2, 2003. **Does this June 2, 2003 summons replace the May 15, 2003 meeting? Was the May 15, 2003 meeting a summons too? Or was it an audit?**

Should I forget about your May 15th meeting and the IRS LETTER that your area director Frank Nixon sent me? I still do not understand what you meant in The IRS LETTER about a **prefiling-notification**. **Can you please explain what it is and how I need to prepare for it?** I sure would like to work with you on this but if you continue to keep me in the dark, I am afraid I will not be able to be very helpful to you.

Santa Ana is about 80 miles from my residence. Since you do not mind coming 80 miles to my home to personally serve a summons on me and are getting paid by our tax dollars no matter what you do, why don't we meet in Hesperia, the city next door to Phelan or half way between Santa Ana and Phelan in Ontario? I will have several witnesses, audio and video record the meeting so that I would not need to hurriedly take notes. If need be, I could rent a hotel room for us to meet where everyone would be comfortable and get to the business at hand.

Please let me know if Hesperia or Ontario would be better for you. Tuesday and Thursdays are usually best for me, although I am open to meeting on other weekdays if it is absolutely necessary. I prefer late mornings or early afternoons. Again I am open to other times, however, I hope that we can accommodate your preferences and mine in arranging our meeting.

I am still waiting for an answer to my Privacy Act/FOIA request letter of April 30, 2003 and the simple questions that I asked of you in my RESPONSE LETTER. Can you forward a copy of your files to the Disclosure Officer to send to me or, perhaps you yourself can send me a copy of the documents that I requested.

Anyway, I hope I can get some answers so that we can put this whole thing behind us real soon.
